Next Field Trip Saturday August 21 LEANING PINE ARBORETUM

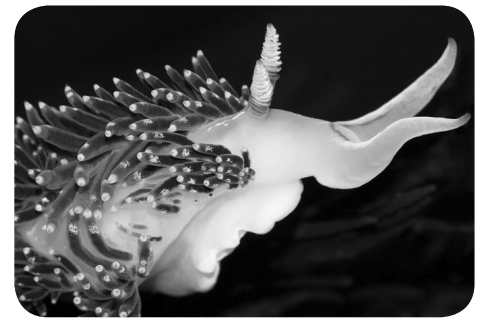
