**Suggested equipment:** If there is sun I would not bring a tripod because it will get crowded. I'm taking my wide angle zoom as the people in costumes will pose for you when you ask them and you can get real close. A flash may also help to bring out the colors in dark areas.

Use the public parking garages if you plan on being there for more than 2 hours. Please email me if you plan on attending so I can get a rough idea how many people will show up.
